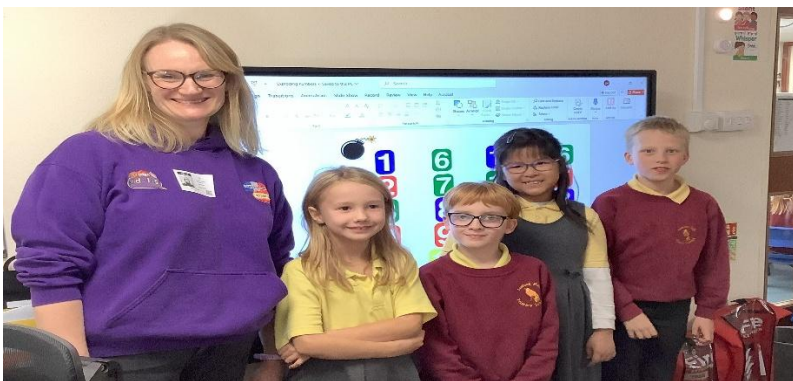
## Message from Mrs Dockry
